Requirements and guidelines for participation

Cost: \$15 to enter

\$25 to purchase a ski or snowboards (all proceeds of ski sales will go directly to CHILL)

Participation Deadline: Registration and ski pick up will be available from January 1st –7th.

Acquire a Ski: BYOS (Bring your own ski or snowboard) or purchase a ski or snowboard for \$25 (We have limited availability for snowboards. they will be available on a first come basis)

Deadline: Return ski or snowboard to STH on or before February 1st.

Subject Matter: Please use discretion & avoid controversial subjects including but not limited to politics, religion, nudity, or disturbing imagery. The Shelburne Tap House has the right to remove any works of art that they feel may break these guidelines.

Display: Artwork will be photographed and mounted at the Shelburne Tap House from February 6th—March 1st

Meet the Artist: A brief artist event hour will be held on Sunday February 5th 1-3pm for the artists & family/friends.

Auction: An online auction will be held from February 6th– 13th on 32auctions.com. Artwork not sold during the auction will be available
